We are open to congregations that are affiliated with the Council's member denominations, faith communities not affiliated with the Council (Christian or of other faiths), and organizations sharing our concern for specific issues.

The Council broadens the commonly held perception of how people of faith view our call in the world. We provide a collective voice by way of advocacy, training, and resources for the faithfully progressive. We represent you in legislative discussions, in meetings with like-minded organizations, with elected officials, and in the public eye. We give voice to the voiceless and their allies grounded in the call of faith.

- Our work includes:
  - NC Interfaith Power & Light:** Connecting the faith voice around climate change and engaging in the public policy process by advocating with compassion.
  - Partners in Health & Wholeness:** Seeking to provide people of faith with the tools to live healthier, more fulfilling lives.
  - NC Religious Coalition for Justice for Immigrants:** Gathering concerned individuals across faiths to change the harsh rhetoric of the current immigration debate and remind people of faith that our primary religious calling is to love one another.
  - Grassroots Advocacy:** Providing the tools and information for people of faith to understand and speak up about what matters most to them.
